Wherever I am, there my servant will also be. My Father will honor whoever serves me. 27 "Now I am deeply troubled.[b] What should I say? 'Father, save me from this time'? No, for this is the reason I have come to this time. 28 Father, glorify your name!" Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again." 29 The crowd standing there heard and said, "It's thunder." Others said, "An angel spoke to him." 30 Jesus replied, "This voice wasn't for my benefit but for yours. 31 Now is the time for judgment of this world.
